Haz-Mat Incident Commander: The Hazardous Materials Incident Commander is defined as that person responsible for all incident activities, including the development of strategies and tactics and the ordering and release of resources.

NFPA 472: Standard for Competence of Responders to Hazardous Materials/Weapons of Mass Destruction Incidents, Chapter 8 provides requirements for competencies for incident commanders responsible for the on-scene management of hazardous materials emergencies and is the primary response industry standard. NFPA 472 is written from a broad perspective - establishing a framework that can be applied to a wide variety of incidents regardless of the hazardous material(s) that may be involved, but does not provide product specific guidance for individual products, such as the crude oil or ethanol.
